April 2016 Schedule

The Summer Aid Application is only needed if you wish to apply for Summer Federal Work Study (FWS)

Undergraduate and Graduate students **not applying for FWS** will automatically be reviewed for Summer Federal and Institutional Aid if:

- Enrolled in at least 1 summer unit
- Does not have a May 2016 grad date
- Has an official 2015-2016 FAFSA on file

Undergraduate students wishing to be considered for Summer Institutional Grant Aid must additionally be:

- Enrolled in at least 6 summer units by April 30 (student must be enrolled in at least 6 units by June 1 to receive these funds, otherwise funds will be cancelled)

Summer aid will be awarded the first week in April and will continue bi-weekly through July 31, 2015.

- Undergraduate - 6 units*
- Graduates - 5 units**

Internships with the Pima County Superior Court IN SUMMER 2016

Students are invited to supplement their academic curriculum by interning in the Pima County Superior Court's **Pretrial Services Release Assessment Division** located at the Pima County Adult Detention Center OR in the **Pretrial Release Services Division** located at 150 W. Congress.

The general focus of the internship is to provide students with the opportunity to work in a structured criminal justice setting and develop professional-caliber skills related to conducting interviews, assessing information and writing reports. Interns interview defendants, conduct background investigations and assist in preparation of reports for the Court.

Intern candidates:

- Must be at least 20 years of age and work the designated hours of the intern position on a part-time basis.
- Must commit to intern a minimum of 135 hours per semester.
- Must have no Felony Convictions.
- Must agree to submit to fingerprinting and criminal history check.
- Must agree to sign a "No Hostage" waiver for the Sheriff's Department.

Our internship program is open to all majors and provides an opportunity for students to learn, first hand, how a Congressional office operates. Interns work closely with staff to create a team that is accessible and responsive to the constituents of Arizona's Congressional District 2. Our internship opportunities are unpaid, but we are more than happy to work with students to help earn school credits. Interns are required to do at least two shifts of four hours twice a week. The shifts are from 9:00am-1:00pm and from 1:00pm-5:00pm. There are also full time positions available where schedules permit.

Interns perform a variety of duties including day-to-day administrative work, data entry, answering phones, drafting constituent correspondence, helping constituents work with federal agencies, and assisting staff where necessary.

Please keep in mind that internships are competitive. Prospective interns will be contacted regarding an interview following a review of credentials.
